  - Other members comment freely on their perspectives
  - Motion to approve the directors' actions of the past year (for a vote)

  - Motion to adjourn the annual members' meeting
4. Heatwole opens (brief) directors' meeting
  - Directors briefly state any important news and raise issues requiring attention
  - Motion to adjourn the directors' meeting.
5. Tim Zavarella, current chapter Alpha, gives an overview of student life for Phi Kaps this year and introduces other students who have arranged to make comments.
6. Mikus, host for the Zoom event, determines need for breakout "rooms," depending on number of brothers present, and opens floor for general conversation.
