You may notice that the photos in this issue by Zosman are new concepts that have called for a lot of creative thinking on the part of the active chapter and also consider that with the COVID vaccinations processed, we are looking forward to resuming for the fall semester. Details of resuming are still to be determined by the Active Chapter, the Interfraternity and the Association of Independent Greek Groups (AIGG). I hope to have further information to provide in the next issue.

I am pleased to note that we have used this hiatus in operations to perform some much-needed maintenance at the chapter house. A decision was made some years ago that we added the fifth floor to the chapter house, but that work was done approximately 25 years ago. Use of the property required continuous maintenance, and we had a lot of work

We combined most of the work into a major maintenance contract, which Brother John Cloutier has managed and which is now nearly complete. We are grateful that we were able to use the Residential Residence Development Fund (RRDF), along with the recent work that was performed on the exterior of the chapter house, to make up for the required interior maintenance work, the chapter house is in excellent physical condition, which places our active chapter in a strong position to continue serving future Phi Kaps. However, it is important for all of us to understand that the RRDF depends on the generosity of the members of the MIT community.
