Dear Brothers:

The COVID pandemic is not over, but MIT has managed its way to a point where students can return to in-person learning and once again live in their fraternity houses. That means that we Phi Kaps can once again celebrate the founding of Alpha Mu Chapter, and our alumni corporation can once again have an annual members’ meeting.

These events will occur together on **Saturday, October 16, 2021**, and you are invited. Because the pandemic is still a real threat, MIT has a number of rules that will govern our events. Accordingly, we have decided to have a hybrid celebration: both in person at 530 Beacon Street and online via Zoom teleconferencing. The Zoom component will be hosted from the house so that even those not present at the house will be able to see a tour of the house, as well as to see and to talk with brothers who are present.

The rules require that one must be fully vaccinated to attend an event in person, and he must wear a mask while indoors, except while eating and drinking. Of course, we also ask that you not attend in person if you have tested positive for the virus in the two weeks before October 16 or if you believe that you have been recently exposed to it. The only other requirement is that you sign in and out at the front door in case there is a need for contact tracing.


Founders’ Day will begin with the alumni corporation’s annual members’ meeting at 4:00 p.m. We will start with discussion of any new business and brief reports on the major renovation just completed and our financial position; this will lead to the usual election of directors and a vote on approval of the existing board’s actions over the past two years, after which we will adjourn and take a brief break, if time allows. Then, Founders’ Day festivities will continue at 5:00 p.m. with a tour of the house broadcast via Zoom.

At about 5:30 p.m., appetizers will be offered for those attending in person, and this will be followed by dinner at 6:15 p.m.
